Update about the following ongoing Village activities for June, 2024.

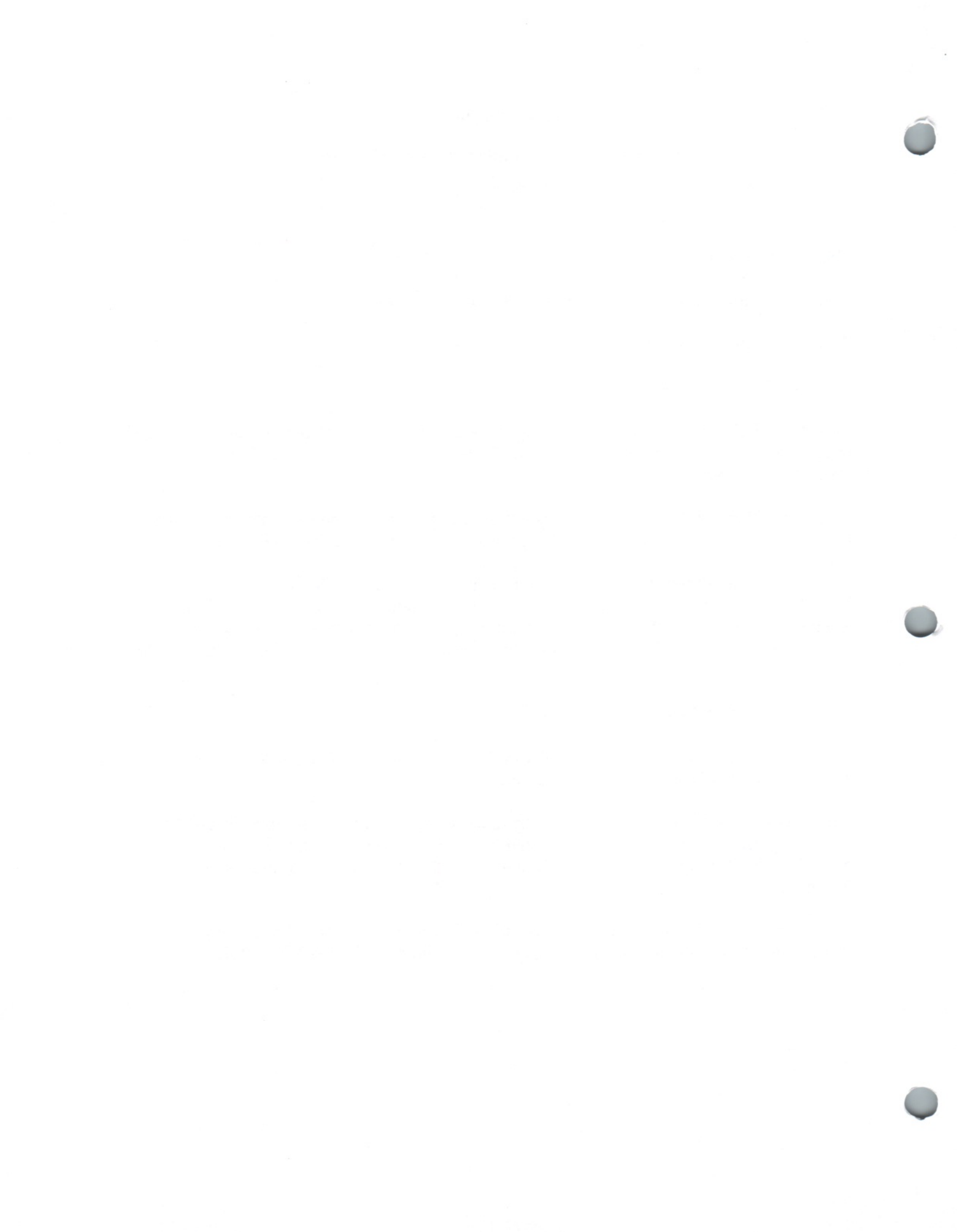
The LCRA has changed the watering schedule to Phase 1 but we have decided to remain in Phase 2 which is normal for us during the summer months. Water once a week and check the new hours for watering – only 6am – 10am and 7pm-11pm on the same day.

Reminder: Fireworks are prohibited in Briarcliff.

Also, oak trees may be trimmed as of July 1 until February 1, 2025. All wounds must be sealed immediately with tree wound dressing.

I have contracted with Lone Star Paving to repaint the road center stripe throughout Briarcliff. I have asked the BPOA maintenance crew to refresh the white stop lines. I've also identified trees that need to be trimmed along our roads – there are numerous areas that need to be cut back.

For anyone that hasn't heard, Jan Libby, the BPOA office manager for many years, died of a sudden heart attack last Sunday at home. I lowered the BPOA flag today.
