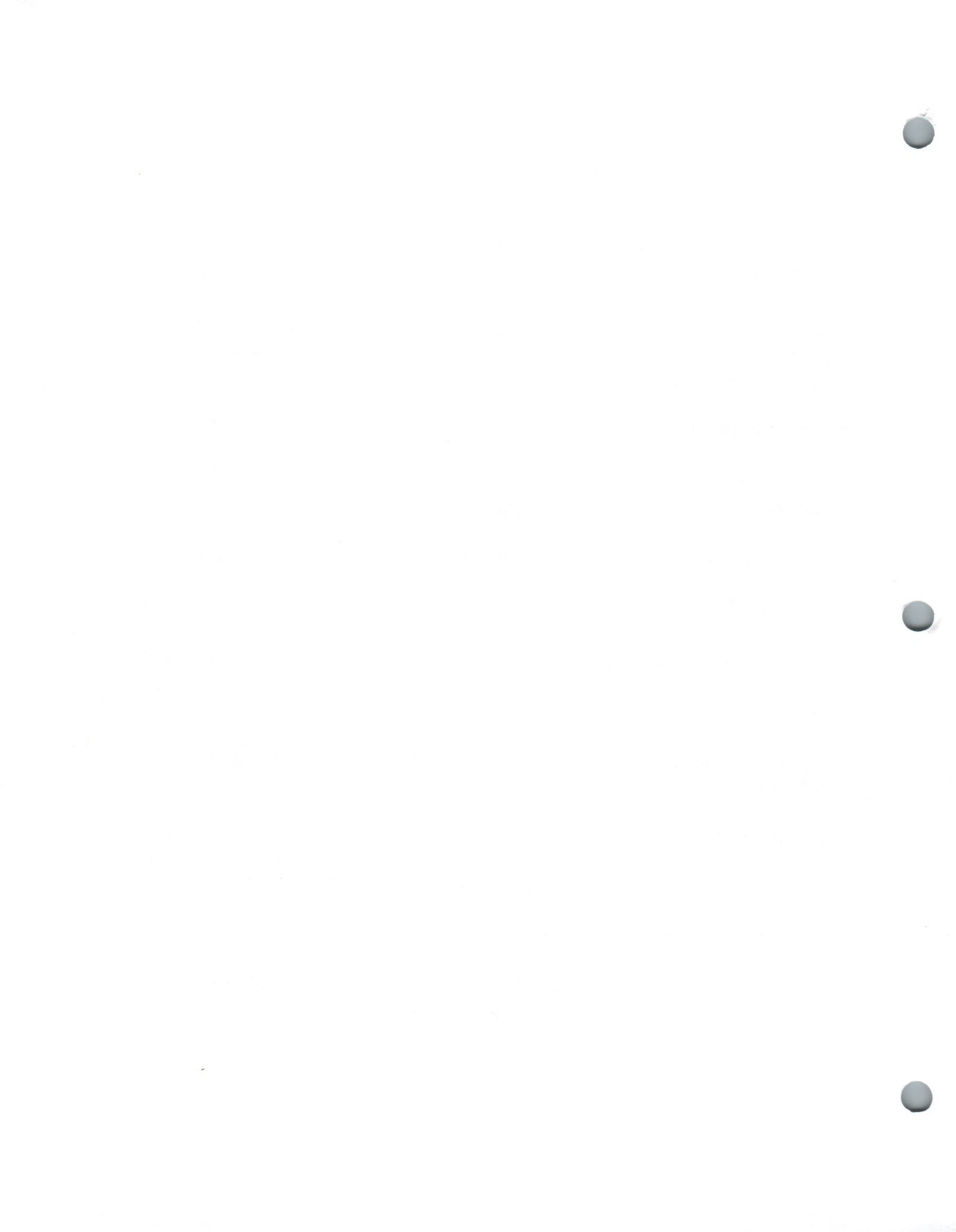
Present: Alderman Aldrich, Charlesworth, Johnston, Richmond, and Taylor.
